# Instructions for the Taragate Battery Prodder

## I. Preparation before using:

1. Follow the user's manual when you operate a prodder.
2. Choose the right shaft that allows you to keep a safe working distance from all livestock.
3. Check that all connections are clean and dry.
4. Insert the shaft into the handle and tighten the lock nut.
5. Check that all the batteries are installed properly in the battery pack and that all connections are firmly fastened.

## II. Operational Instructions:

1. Turn the switch of the prodder to the "ON" position. Turn it "OFF" if you don't use it, to prevent accidental shock.
2. To operate the prodder, press the button on the prodder, touch the rear of the animal with the two electrodes, the prodder releases effective electric shock, release the button. A light touch makes the most effective results.
3. Because of potential for increase in intensity, operate the prodder carefully when the animals are wet.

## III. How to change the batteries:

1. Undo the screw to take out the battery pack and open its cover, you will see four batteries. (Model: LR14, alkaline "C" cell batteries)
2. Remove the batteries and install the new ones. Pay attention to the polarity of the batteries. Tighten the battery pack screw.

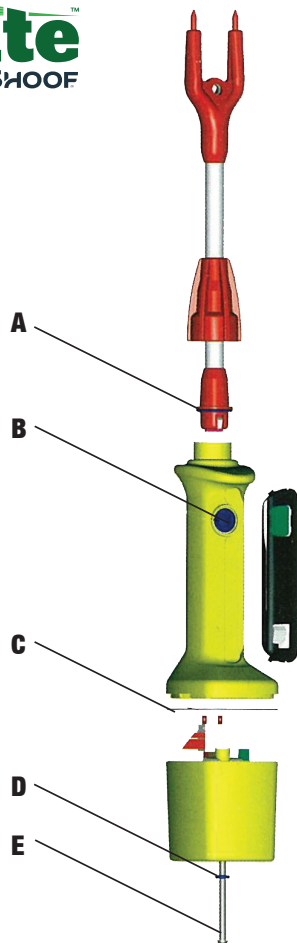

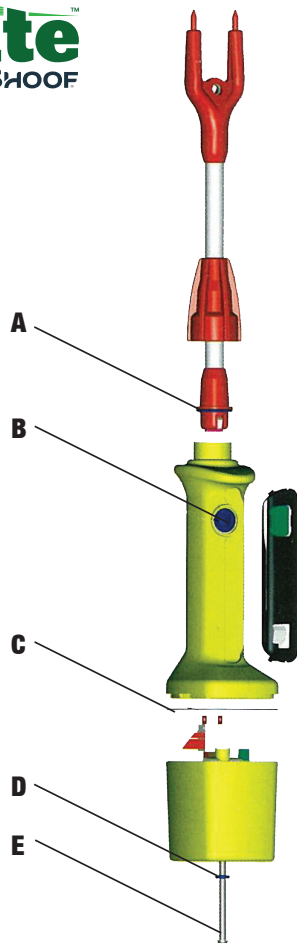
