



Kerbl Horse Muzzles

Horse Muzzles from Kerbl are sized into the following bridle sizes and are based on the size of the horse they are intended to fit. The most common sizes are:

Shetland:

- Designed for Shetland ponies and other very small breeds.
- Typically, smaller than "Pony" size and accommodates their petite heads.
- Crownpiece: 28–32 cm, Noseband: 46–51 cm, Cheekpiece: 12–15 cm.

Pony:

- For small ponies, usually under 14 hands (56 inches at the withers).
- Fits breeds like Welsh Ponies and other similarly sized equines.
- Crownpiece: 34–38 cm, Noseband: 51–56 cm, Cheekpiece: 15–18 cm.

Cob:

- For slightly larger ponies or smaller horse breeds, generally 14–15.2 hands.
- Fits compact horses like Connemaras, NZ stationbreds and Australian stock horses.
- Crownpiece: 38–43 cm, Noseband: 56–61 cm, Cheekpiece: 18–21 cm.

Full (Horse):

- For average-sized horses, usually 15.2–16.2 hands.
- Common for breeds like Thoroughbreds, Quarter Horses, and similar types.
- Crownpiece: 43–48 cm, Noseband: 61–66 cm, Cheekpiece: 21–25 cm.

NOTES:

- These measurements are general guidelines only.
- To measure your horse's head, use a flexible measuring tape as follows:
 - Crownpiece: Measure from one bit ring, over the poll, to the other bit ring.
 - Noseband: Measure around the horse's nose about two fingers below the cheekbones.
 - Cheekpiece: Measure from the bit ring to the point where the crownpiece attaches above the ear.
