3. The charger light will glow red when charging. When it turns green the unit is fully charged. Charging will take 8 - 10 hours.

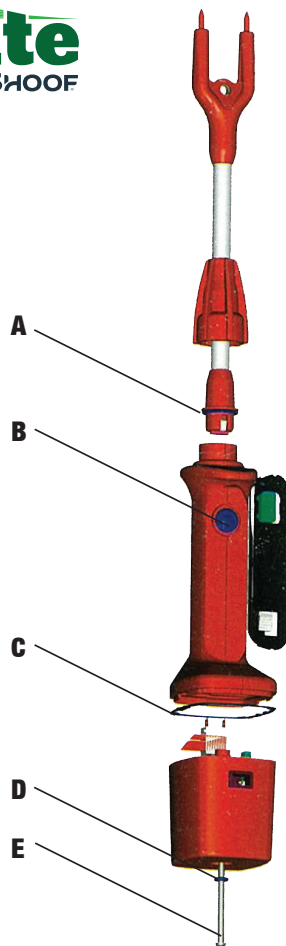

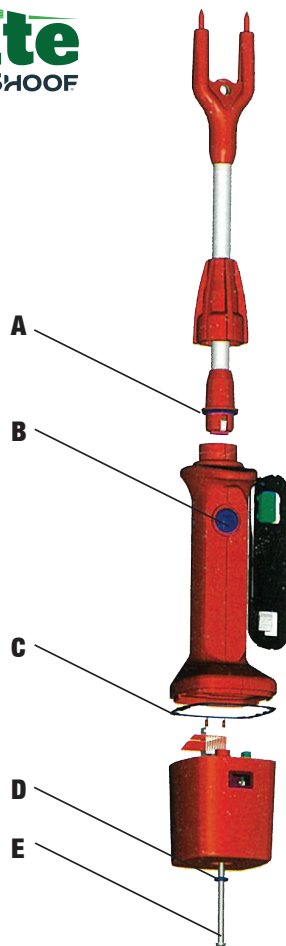
