Designed in New Zealand and developed by Shoof International Ltd, the hoof sock solves the problem many farriers face of poulticing hooves without 'stewing' them. The PVC-moulded hoof sock 'breathes' whilst still protecting and soaking the damaged hoof, and can be quickly and easily applied without the need for dressings and tape.

Tubbease allows the use of a variety of remedies and can also be used over hoof wraps and dressings for additional protection and cleanliness in wet or muddy conditions. The EVA Sole Insert

(sold separately) adds an additional layer of comfort for sensitive soles and will relieve pain and extend the life of Tubbease.

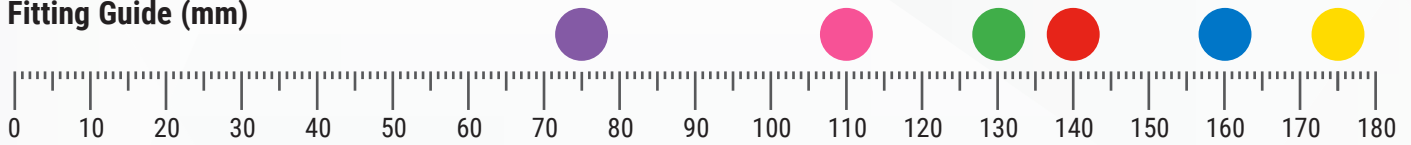

# Tubbease Hoof Sock



## Fitting Guide (mm)



**Please note:** Measurements indicate maximum internal width of Tubbease.



1. After preparing or medicating the hoof, open sock wide and pull Tubbease over hoof using tabs at side.



2. Check Tubbease is fitting hoof correctly and then pull sock up carefully.



3. With sock taut, fit hook and loop strap to lower pastern with hook side facing sock. Ensure one finger space under strap.



4. With hoof on the ground, simply pour in treatment solution as required, or submerge fitted hoof into a bucket of your chosen solution for deeper soaking.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Tubbease Hoof Socks are not enduring boots. They are for short term use in confined enclosures by restrained animals. Judgement should be exercised.
